Message from the Lodge Manager Happily Reopened

Last Wednesday was our official reopening day from recently lifted COVID-19 state restrictions. While we are still only able to offer patio dining, members stood ready to enjoy our outdoor heated space. Friday's \$15 steak dinner filled the patio with hungry, happy diners. The night was so successful, we will continue to offer Steak dinners the 1st Friday of every month. **This Friday will be a pre-Valentine's Day event, "Dinner and a Movie" featuring *When Harry Met Sally* playing on our 8 foot outdoor movie screen.** The dinner special will be Chicken Marsala with mashed potatoes and mixed veggies, all for \$12 (Movie FREE). Our regular menu is always offered along with any Friday dinner specials we may have.

Bingo is back, always on the 3rd Friday of the month and **live music on the 4th Friday. This month on the 26th, the "Friday 3" will play from the American Songbook, music from the 1920's - 1950's.** The trio features keyboards, guitar and a trumpet. This is bound to be a toe-tapping entertaining event, so come by for music and a dinner special of meatloaf, mashed potatoes and green beans.

Spring will bring a St. Patrick's Day celebration and a huge yard sale in our parking lot (date to be determined). We are currently cleaning out the two large containers located in the back in hopes of selling one of them, enabling us to include a lounge area in time for summer. Hopefully, the larger back area will also include a small bar and an additional large television. The board and I never stop thinking about improvements to our Lodge which our members will enjoy.

We are also creating a blind wine tasting ticketed event in March, with the winning bottle added to our wine list. Tickets will cost \$10 and a cheese plate will be included with the tasting. This will be an on going, every other month event, with a **blind beer tasting** on the alternating month. This will allow me to create a member approved wine and beer list. 

nights as a way for the Women of the Moose to make money as the chapter gets to keep the tips that we earn. Please let us know if you can spare a few hours one Friday.




Bring your Moose Card!
